<u>By care:</u> Highway A9 (Lausanne, Montreux, Simplon) until exit n°17 Aigle. Drive through Aigle and follow Col des Mosses. When you arrive at Sepey village, turn left and follow Leysin.

By train: Take the train from Geneva or Lausanne until Aigle. There take the little train to Leysin. Stop at Leysin-Vermont.
